Section II - General Information and Authorized Signatures

This permit entitles the person named above to utilize metal detectors in parks and properties managed by Roanoke Parks and Recreation, with the following exceptions:

- Use of metal detectors on or near athletic fields: Metal detectors shall not be utilized within the boundaries of any athletic field, whether it is designated as a practice, game or tournament level field. Additionally, metal detectors shall stay at least 10' outside of boundary lines or fences or other markings which delineate athletic fields.
- Use of metal detectors near restrooms, picnic shelters or other stationary buildings within parks: Metal detectors shall remain at least 10' from these structures, so not to damage any plumbing and/or electrical pipes or wires, as well as to minimize potential injury to the detector's operator.
- Use of metal detectors under trees and within the drip line of trees shall be prohibited. The "drip line" is defined as a straight line extending downward from the tips of branches reaching farthest from the main tree trunk or tree canopy. This protects the tree roots found near the surface from damage incurred by digging or trenching.
- Use of metal detectors on any stone, gravel or earthen or other natural surface trail or greenway

Your permit is not valid until signed by the Parks and Recreation Manager. Your permit should be carried at all times while using your metal detector.
