This is a multi-use trail, so expect a wide variety of users moving at different speeds: be conscious of your surroundings and considerate with your speed



Walk and ride on the right side, pass on the left

On crowded sections or busy days, please walk or ride single file to allow others to pass

If pausing for a break or to chat with a fellow Greenway fan, step off to the side of the path to avoid collisions



No alcohol, camping, hunting or fires


ELECTRIC-POWERED BIKES AND NON-MOTORIZED BIKES, SCOOTERS, **SKATES AND SKATEBOARDS ARE WELCOME ON THE GREENWAYS. IF YOU ARE RIDING ANYTHING WITH WHEELS:**



Wear a helmet!

Always ride single-file; slow down in sections with low visibility

Remember that pedestrians always have the right-of-way



FOR GREENWAY USERS BRINGING PETS:

Make sure all four-legged friends' exploring is done on leash and does not trip or disturb fellow visitors

Please dispose of all pet waste—look for Mutt Mitt stations if you need a bag or trash can!
